

JUNIOR GOLF POLICY

The Bluenose Golf Club has a tradition of providing a very active program for Junior Golfers. The Bluenose Golf Club has been engaged with junior and amateur golf throughout the history of the club, and provides significant teaching and training opportunities for new golfers and those playing competitively.

- All Adult Volunteers who work directly with the Junior Program will have completed a Criminal Record/Vulnerable Sector Check.

To ensure that Junior Golfers enjoy the privilege of a membership, while adhering to the current Bluenose Golf Club policies, the following guidelines shall be enforced at all times:

- Junior Golfers 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times while on Bluenose Golf Club property
- Every Tuesday in July & August we are offering clinics for our junior members. Please fill out the appropriate membership form, junior golf registration sheet and covid questionnaire before arriving at the first clinic you will be attending. All forms can be submitted in person to the Pro Shop.
- If a Junior Golfer wishes to play on the course at any other time besides the junior clinic on Tuesdays, they may book tee times up to 2 days in advance. A tee time must be booked to play; walk-ons are not permitted. All are expected to complete the 9-hole round within the recommended time period to keep the tee times on schedule. If a group can not keep pace, they may be asked to let faster groups play through or skip holes to maintain the pace of play. This will be at the discretion of the Pro Shop staff.
- Junior Golfers are eligible to receive one free large bag of range balls per day. The driving range is booked in 30 minute blocks with a maximum of 6 golfers using it at one time. The driving range is available by appointment only; walk-ons are not permitted. Call the Pro Shop at 902-634-4260 to book a range time
- The health and safety of all golfers and employees are the top priority at Bluenose Golf Club. All Junior Golfers are asked to review the most current Covid 19 policy on the Bluenose Golf Club website before arriving to ensure a safe experience at the club. Those found not following the Covid 19 policy; especially the social distancing guidelines, will be disciplined accordingly:
 - 1st occurrence – verbal warning
 - 2nd occurrence – written warning
 - 3rd occurrence – suspension of playing privileges or possible loss of membership

Every occurrence will be dealt with on an individual basis and at the discretion of the Pro Shop staff.
